#### RAP14.

##### MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:

056 The minutes from the previous meeting held on 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2014 were accepted as a true and accurate record.

##### BUSINESS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES:

057 Ref. RAP14.045 - Rally Car Registration Scheme

Panel noted that the Qld State Council Chairman had agreed to send a letter to CEO CAMS in an endeavour to have this matter expedited. Panel also noted that many competitors who are building or awaiting registration of new cars are becoming increasingly concerned. After discussion Panel agreed to provide further information to CAMS CEO on the impacts of delays in the implementation of the Scheme.

- 058 Ref. RAP14.046 - Wowan QRC 5  
Update given on progress with the planning of Wowan QRC 5 - All is progressing well with all permits received and entries due to close later this month. The Chair and other QRAP members will attend this event. Marius Swart is to follow up with Al Stean (Hankook Tyre) to ensure good presence at Wowan.
- 059 Ref. RAP14.048 - 2014 Rally Awards Dinner  
After discussion of optional dates, Panel agreed the Rally Awards Dinner will be held at Kedron Wavell RSL on 7 February 2015.

#### **CORRESPONDENCE:**

- 060 Panel received an email with a letter to Qld Rally from Malcolm Wallis, Tourism Economic Development Officer of Kyogle Council thanking the organisers for a wonderful event and advising of future support from Council to ensure the event is retained in northern NSW. Panel noted this letter and also noted that GCTMSC has responded to it on behalf of Panel.
- 061 Panel received an email from Col Trinder (ARCom) advising of the draft classes for classic cars in 2015 and requesting that these be circulated to competitors with a suitable advice as to potential changes before they are finally ratified and implemented. Panel Chair to do a suitable covering email and send to CAMS Qld Office for distribution.

#### **GENERAL BUSINESS:**

- 062 Date and Venue Change - QRC 6  
Panel Chair reported that due to a number of issues with the availability of suitable HQ venues for QRC 6 as scheduled for 8 November 2014, it is proposed that Panel support a request to State Council to ratify a change of venue and date for QRC 6. The proposed date is now Saturday 22 November 2014 and the location of the event HQ will be Imbil. It was noted that this is the day before a GCTMSC Khanacross and a HSCCQ Khanacross. Panel agreed that State Council be asked to ratify the change of date and venue for QRC 6 to show Saturday 22 November 2014 at Imbil.
- 063 2015 Rally Calendar of Events  
Panel discussed potential QRC calendar for 2015 and proposed that there be 6 rounds again in 2015. The following suggestions were offered for consideration by Clubs and response for input to CAMS Calendar discussions;  
QRC 1 – Manumbar (early March) BSCC  
QRC 2 – Wowan (3<sup>rd</sup> week April) CQMSC  
QRC 3/4 – International Rally of Qld (late June date to be confirmed by FIA) BSCC  
QRC 5 – Border Ranges (1<sup>st</sup> week August) GCTMSC  
QRC 6 – Imbil (early November) BSCC
- 064 2015 Qld Rally Handbook  
Panel discussed potential areas for review in the 2015 Qld Rally Handbook. These include giving options for organisers to adopt separate distances for Clubman competitors in QRC rounds, clarification of the nomination of class or category on entry forms for QRC events and better definition of what cars are eligible for “All-Comers”. Panel members to canvass competitors and provide input to allow drafting of the 2015 Qld Rally Handbook.
