##### AGENDA ITEMS:

074 2013 Qld Rally Championship and Series Schedule  
After discussion, revisions to the schedule were agreed to by Panel. The amended schedule to be sent to CAMS Qld Office.

- 075 Eligibility of Unrestricted Turbo 4WD Vehicles in 2013 QRC  
 After detailed discussion on the many aspects of this issue, the Panel agreed to make the following recommendation to State Council:  
 "That unrestricted turbo 4WD vehicles may become eligible for use in 2013 QRC events (including Junior Rally Driver, Clubman and All Comer Series) subject to (a) those vehicles using only 98 RON commercial unleaded fuel and (b) QSC being satisfied that a workable and cost-effective fuel-testing regime for these vehicles can be implemented to ensure compliance with this fuel standard."
- 076 RAP Rally Dinner - 16 February 2013  
 Panel received updates on actions to date. Paul Woodward is to follow up with Sheridan on status of planning and what actions still need to be addressed.
- 077 CAMS Rally Levy Reports  
 Panel considered the reports on the 2012 balances of Qld Rally Registration Fund, Qld Sportsman Series Fund and Qld Pocket Rocket Rally Series Funds. Panel agreed that the recommendation for the disbursement to organising clubs (GCTMC & BSCC) of funds from the Qld Rally Registration Fund and Qld Sportsman Series Fund should be further considered at the March 2013 RAP meeting when all expenses from the funds will have been paid.

 Panel moved a vote of thanks to Jamie Macfarlane for his service on RAP and his Chairmanship of Panel during 2012.
