



Calling all QRC Competitors

Qld State Council has approved that for 2017 only, a new QRC Round 6 will be run as part of Rally Australia as a one day pace-noted event on Saturday 18 November 2017. Recce will be held on Friday 17 November so that the time away from work is reduced. Presentations will be held immediately after the event, so crews can head home on Sunday, stay and spectate or maybe run the Sunday stages (non-pointsoring for QRC).

Details of the Saturday Stages are being finalised. Queensland Rally Advisory Panel will continue to liaise with the Organisers (Rally Australia) to ensure that the QRC competitors are well looked after and the Supplementary Regulations reflect our Handbook. It is expected that the entry fee will be reasonable and Rallysafe will be used.

This is a once off opportunity for the QRC to be run with Rally Australia and recent announcements by RA such as the Kennards Cup show what is on offer, other than points in the last round of the 2017 QRC.

Rally Panel is working closely with Rally Australia to make sure we get accurate event details out to QRC competitors as soon as these are finalised. Both Panel and RA are keen to make sure that all releases are accurate. Further details will be released as available

In the meantime, if you intend to enter please plan your travel time to meet recce on Friday 17/11 and the QRC 6 event on Saturday 18/11. Please also get your accommodation booked in the Coffs area asap.
